



Bike Intensive Inclement Weather Policy

Our Bike Intensive is an outdoor program, and weather conditions are monitored closely for safety and instructional quality.

Weather Decisions

If significant rain, thunderstorms, unsafe temperatures, or hazardous conditions are expected, MOCO will determine whether sessions need to be modified, delayed, relocated, or rescheduled.

- Whenever possible, decisions will be made by **7:00 AM** for morning sessions.

Please ensure we have the best phone number to reach you for same-day weather updates.

Rescheduling / Alternate Times

When possible, we will attempt to:

- Move sessions later in the day
- Offer an alternate time that same day

Because of instructor scheduling and limited availability, alternate times cannot always be guaranteed.

Attendance During Weather Adjustments

If an alternate lesson time is offered and a family is unable to attend, the missed session may not be eligible for an additional makeup lesson.

Indoor / Alternate Training Locations

In some situations, MOCO may utilize alternate training spaces when appropriate. While families typically meet instructors near the tennis court area at White Flint Local Park, instruction is not limited to a single court location and may shift based on safety, space availability, or training needs.

MOCO is also actively exploring additional covered and indoor training options with enough open riding space to safely support instruction and skill progression similar to a tennis court setup.

Safety First

The safety of our riders, families, and instructors always comes first. Conditions such as wet pavement, lightning, poor visibility, or excessive heat may require schedule changes even if rain appears minimal.

We appreciate families' flexibility as we work to provide safe and effective instruction.
